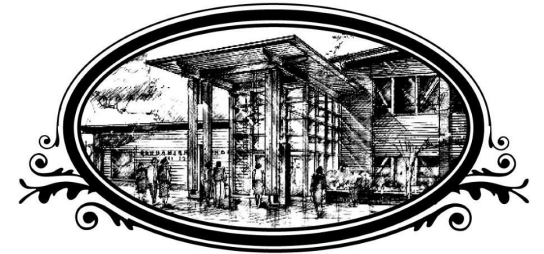

Who we are:

Community service organizations within Sammamish and their volunteers who have the time and expertise to help Sammamish residents in need.

Purpose: Sammamish Cares is a consortium of local community service organizations banded together with the city to aid local homeowners who are unable to maintain their homes and properties.

What we can do:

We can help with simple, onetime repairs that are a necessity for the homeowner, when the homeowner is unable to make the repairs due to a lack of funds; and/or physical or mental incapacity. The projects we do are projects that the homeowner would normally handle but is temporarily unable to. These include yard maintenance and simple repairs. More complex repairs might be referred to Habit for Humanity of East King County and their *A Brush With Kindness* program. Projects for homeowners over the age of 60 will be reviewed by Eastside Friends of Seniors. Homeowners might be asked to cover some of the costs if they are able to.

What we can't do:

We are unable to help with ongoing maintenance or projects which homeowners might reasonably complete themselves.

How to ask for help:

Contact the City of Sammamish Volunteer Coordinator for referral into the program. The Volunteer Coordinator will fill out a short application in person or over the phone. The application will then be forwarded to the Sammamish Cares Operations Committee for review.

Projects are reviewed monthly, and in most situations you should hear back in a few weeks. The Volunteer Coordinator can give you the next scheduled review date. Emergency repairs will be handled on a case by case basis.

For other assistance, ask for the Sammamish Cares Community Brochure for referral to other community organizations that might be better equipped to support you in your time of need.
