Activities during the month and general Discussion (includes Action items)

- Brad shared the maps of the neighborhood that he has obtained from the City of Sammamish. These maps and notes clearly identify the fences that HOA is responsible for. Brad will take an action to notate these and we will have these published on the website
- Brad also mentioned that he has obtained an assessment of the parks and their safety. The general
  consensus is that we should update our parks and would need to assess our costs and timeline to
  have them updated
- Ben joined the board meeting to explain the issues from the hearing on Lawson development. Don agreed to work with an attorney to obtain their legal opinion on how to proceed on the following:

Moving Bus Stops - They are proposing moving the current bus stops (2) from East of 242<sup>nd</sup> Drive SE to West of 242<sup>nd</sup> Drive SE, requiring the kids to cross 242<sup>nd</sup>. The new stop is proposed to be at 241st PI SE. The proposal calls for the construction trucks to move along 242<sup>nd</sup> Drive SE during the construction phase. With no stop signs and crosswalks, how do the kids get across?

- 2. No Stop Sign Currently there is not a stop sign at the corner of SE 11th place and 242<sup>nd</sup> Drive SE. It is already a dangerous interaction, but given the additional traffic expected....the corner needs a stop sign.
- 3. Traffic round-about If 242<sup>nd</sup> Drive SE pushes through the Lawson Development, and there is access to the development from both directions, we have Safety concerns regarding 242nd Drive SE and the opening of 14th St SE. Cars will be coming around that corner pretty quickly. A round-about at that intersection will slow down traffic.
- 4. Impact on Gas Easement There is a large gas easement running the entire distance of 242<sup>nd</sup> Drive SE. The proposal is that they will be moving dirt and other heavy material along 242<sup>nd</sup> Drive SE. This rumbling could impact the gas easement. Has there been a study to ensure that this will not happen?
- 5. Project changes made by the city or applicant of Lawson Park without due process that may affect the RR community
